## HUNTING REPORTS

### Roebuck in the Borders region of Scotland

This is a report on a hunt in the Borders region of Scotland and England with Mike McCrave. On the whole it was a pretty good hunt. Mike also offers a travel guide service for non-hunting companions (staffed by his friend, Mitch Cummings). We only were able to hunt with Mike one day—due to weather and other commitments—but we had Mitch for 5 days and he did a great job of taking us throughout northern England and southern Scotland.

As for the hunt, I was hunting with my son (age 12) who has extensive hunting and travel experience worldwide. However, he is 12 and I think it might have been better had we hunted 2x1 rather than 1x1. Mike seems more accustomed to hunters preferring personalized guiding (1x1) but we would probably have been better 2x1—more camaraderie, etc. I took a small roebuck but my son was not successful. With only one day to hunt, I think that we were lucky to score the one we did. If we had 4 or 5 days I am sure we would have both collected representative animals—perhaps even excellent trophies. There were no other hunters in our area and lots of game sign. Since we arrived in the UK after being in Brazil, I was unable to bring my firearms with me. Mike provided excellent rifles for a nominal fee.

Mike also offers estate and free range hunts for a variety of species and I would like to have the chance to hunt free range Highland stag with him at some time. Actually, he and I had some great conversations about the "MacNab" (stag, salmon, grouse in 24 hrs) and I think that would be an excellent experience. On the whole, I would recommend hunting with Mike (and would do so again) with the only caveat being that, if the hunt is a parent/child combo, one might consider specifying a 2x1 guide arrangement.

Since the hunt really only lasted one day, I think it is probably fair to mention that the touring aspect of the trip was excellent. We stayed in the Roxburghe Country House Hotel (on the estate of the Duke of Roxburghe—it was on some of

his other holdings that we hunted). Good quality lodging, albeit with some age on the plumbing. Driven bird shooting is offered and my son and I availed ourselves of the opportunity to take a wing-shooting lesson from Alistair Ferguson (CPSA Senior Instructor in Sporting, Skeet and Traps), who heads up the Duke's grouse and pheasant activities. I would highly recommend visiting Floors Castle (the Duke's residence) and the village of Kelso, with its' abandoned Abbey ruins. Nearby Jedburgh Abbey is also worth a trip.

If time permits, consider taking the hour-long drive south to Durham (in northern England) to see the Norman castle and cathedral built by William II. In my opinion, Durham cathedral is the

finest extant example of early Norman (English Romanesque) architecture, and arguably the most beautiful cathedral in the UK. A magical place. Farther afield, Edinburgh and St. Andrews offer excellent city and golfing experiences (if you go, remember that St. Andrews is a municipal golf club and that reservations for the Old Course must be made a long time in advance.) There are no rain checks for bad weather; when we were there it was 40° F (mid-August) and the wind was blowing the rain horizontally off the Firth—yet there was a group on every tee, fairway, and green.

I would recommend the entire experience as a great family trip, for hunters and nonhunters alike.

## South African Plains Game Hunt with Somerby Safaris

In June 2012 my wife, Chris, and I traveled to South Africa to hunt plains game with Drom and Sune' Beukes and the Somerby Safari Team. I first met Drom at the Kansas City Sports and Vacation show in 2003 or 2004. I knew then that I would hunt with him someday. We continued to see each other at SCI functions, our friendship continued to develop and my desire to hunt in Africa grew stronger. In January 2011 we finally booked a hunt for June 2012. My custom package included: kudu, gems-buck, zebra, waterbuck and impala.

The long-awaited day finally arrived and we departed KCI for Johannesburg, South Africa. Our expectations were very high and the Somerby Team treated us like royalty. Our expectations were exceeded in every way.

Equipment used included: Browning A-Bolt Stainless Stalker in 300 Win Mag, Leupold 3.5x10 VariX III and Remington 180 grn Sciracco II ammunition. This was an excellent package for a plains game hunt and it performed extremely well.

Hi Guys, I thought you might like to see my elk, taken Nov 14 in Colorado. I took it with one of the outfitters from our Expo last year, Jim Flynn. My guide was Roger Rupp. I've also hunted Mule deer and Mountain Lion with Roger.

I was able to take the five animals in my package and add five more—Red Hartebeest, Black Wildebeest, Blue Wildebeest, Springbuck and Blesbok. Having been raised on a pig farm in Iowa, I told Drom that I was NOT going to shoot a Warthog. My confession got the best of me—after shooting at two, I still did not bring one home—next time ....

Every staff member did their best to make our ten days in South Africa most enjoyable. We spent every day with our PH, Charles, and our very capable support person, Ansa. Chris and I both feel like

we have a new brother and sister in South Africa. We hunted in three different camps in three very different regions of South Africa. There were different levels of service and accommodations at each location but all were awesome.

Chris originally intended to spend very little time hunting to take advantage of the various other opportunities offered. This was her first hunt of any kind. After the first day in the field she opted to spend all of her time hunting. She was able to ride both elephants and horses.

I recommend Drom and Sune' and the Somerby team without reservation, you will not be disappointed. We can hardly wait to go again. I think there is a Cape Buffalo there destined for our trophy room.
