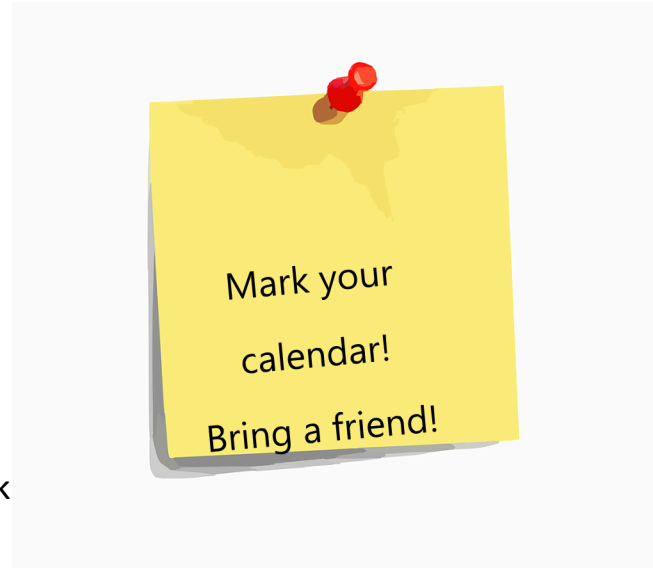

BANQUET HIGHLIGHTS

MARCH 7, 2025

This year's annual Banquet is going to feature a variety of games, a great dinner and speaker, and a live auction.

First some logistical items. The banquet hall at 9000 W 137th Street in Overland Park will open for guests at 5:00. Games will be ready for action and the bar will be open. Bring plenty of \$10 and \$20 bills for the games. (We won't complain about \$100 bills either). Dinner will be served around 6:30. Our menu will be highlighted by Jack Stack BBQ's

Our guest speaker for the dinner is Chris Tymeson, SCI State and Local Liaison and longtime KCSCI supporter and member. Chris's biography will be published separately.

We will be playing our 100 shotgun shell game for \$20 for a shotgun. A dice game will be available, with a choice of a shotgun or a rifle for the winner. New this year will a 50/50 drawing for \$20 tickets and also a 100 square board where you buy a square for \$10 and we will draw a horizontal and a vertical number and the square at that intersection wins a shotgun. Our biggest game and prize is going to be a two deck card game. From a red and blue deck mixed, buy a card for \$20 and tear it in half. You keep half, we will keep the other. When we draw out the winning ½ card, if you have the matching color and card, you will win a beautiful 4.5ctw opal, set with 49 diamonds totaling 4.9ctw and suspended from an 18k gold chain. Our donor values this necklace at \$5,800! We will hold a reserve on this item, we have to sell at least 75 of the 108 cards or the game will revert to 50/50 and we will keep the necklace.

The popular 8-gun table raffle will also be played. This year's cost to sign up for the raffle will be \$30 per person versus the \$20 used for so many years. The Chapter just can't afford to buy rifles at current prices and make any money on this game. To try to offset the pain of a price increase, there will be 8 raffle tickets in each table envelope. But a space on the sheet and you get a raffle ticket. This will be a separate raffle from all others, with the winner getting a shotgun.

Backward Bingo will offer a Savage rifle in .308 Winchester. With a heavy, threaded barrel and a unique camo pattern, this rifle will offer the winner a tack-driving prize. Bingo will remain \$20 per bingo card.

This hunt may NOT be combined with any other safari.

Arrival day costs will be \$225 per person. This 100% donation is good for 2025 or 2026 and can (SHOULD) be added to with animals off the current price list. This hunt may NOT be combined with any other safari.

ZIMBABWE CAST AND BLAST FROM THE SAFARI CONNECTION: This is a donation from Sean Scott, a longtime supporter and member of KCSCI. It is a 7-day safari for one hunter in 2025 including a full day of fishing for Tiger fish on Lake Kariba which is fed by the mighty Zambezi River. The hunt includes a trophy fee for one spotted hyena. The hunt will originate from Victoria Falls and will be conducted from a lake-side camp in the Sijarira Forest area. The winner will receive all lodging and meals. The hunt can be upgraded to include any game available in western Zimbabwe, including elephant, lion, leopard, hippo, crocodile, and many species of plains game including some of the rarer ones. Observers and extra hunters are welcome and can be added at a 25 percent and 15 percent discount respectively if this hunt is purchased by an SCI member. A minimum of 7mm magnum is required if hunter takes their own rifle. The hunt takes place in South Africa and arrival and departure are from Johannesburg airport. This 100% donation is good for 2025 or 2026 and can (SHOULD) be added to with animals off the current price list. This hunt may NOT be combined with any other safari.
